- 80 individuals and households have been approved for more than \$548,850 in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program.
- \$540,300 in U.S. Small Business Administration low-interest disaster loans have been approved for six homeowners and renters as of Nov. 20.

Housing Assistance:

- \$406,552 in grants are approved for housing repairs or replacement for 59 homeowners.
- \$142,298 in grants have been approved for personal property, transportation and other disasterrelated serious needs for 64 applicants.
- 707 home inspections have been issued with 99 percent completed.
