- The deadline to apply with FEMA for disaster assistance is Nov. 30. Survivors may apply by visiting <u>disasterassistance.gov</u>, checking <u>FEMA's mobile app</u>, or by calling **800-621-3362** (TTY: 800-462-7585). The toll-free telephone lines operate 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. PST, seven days a week.
- 11 individuals and households have been approved for \$48,572 in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program.
- \$30,000 in U.S. Small Business Administration low-interest disaster loans have been approved for two homeowners and/or renters as of Nov. 20.

## **Housing Assistance:**

- \$11,299 in grants approved for housing repairs or replacement for seven homeowners.
- \$37,273 in grants have been approved for personal property, transportation and other disasterrelated serious needs for 10 applicants.
- 95 home inspections have been issued with 99 percent completed.
